ENVIRONMENTAL

Environmental ASB such as fly-tipping, dog-fouling, littering, graffiti, abandoned vehicles and noise complaints can be reported to the Council's Environmental Health Team on 01909 533 219 or online via www.bassetlaw.gov.uk/report-a-problem.

HOUSING

If the anti-social behaviour being committed involves a Council property, whether it be the tenant(s) or visitor(s), the Council's Housing Team should be contacted initially on 0800 590542 or online via: www.bassetlaw.gov.uk/councilhousing/council-housing-services-online/

OTHER

Any other ASB should be reported to the Council's ASB Team on 01909 533253 or online via www.bassetlaw.gov.uk/ash.

Often cases will be referred to different teams and for more complex issues, there will be a multi-agency response.
